CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AS COMMON CARRIER OF SPECIAL COMMODITIES NO. 5268-F

Oilfield equipment, machinery and supplies, and commodities that due to size or weight require special handling, transportation of waste by flatbed trucks that is incidental to the production and discovery of oil and gas, and transportation of passengers on a call and demand basis.

In the following described territory:

From, to and between all points and places in the State of Louisiana, over irregular routes.

Transportation of waste, statewide, restricted against the use of vacuum trucks;

Restricted against the transportation to or from oil well sites in vacuum tank trucks;

Restricted against the use of roll on/roll off boxes, dump trucks and dump trailers.

As a restricted common carrier by motor vehicle transporting oilfield equipment, machinery; pipe line equipment and machinery; oilfield supplies and pipe line supplies; heavy machinery, heavy or cumbersome commodities and parts to and from all points and places and over all routes and highways in the state of Mississippi.
